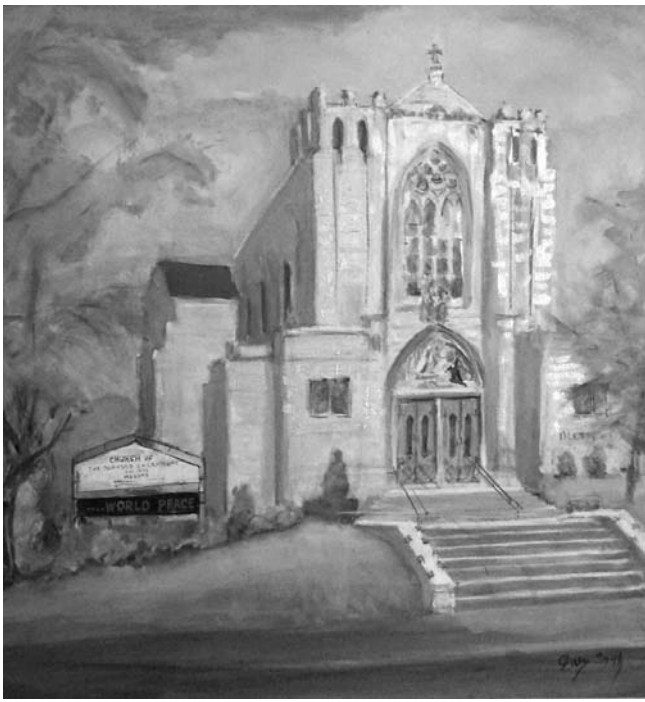

From the Pastor's Desk - Our Parish Feast Day

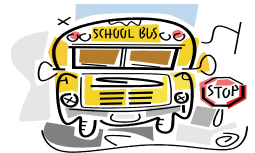
