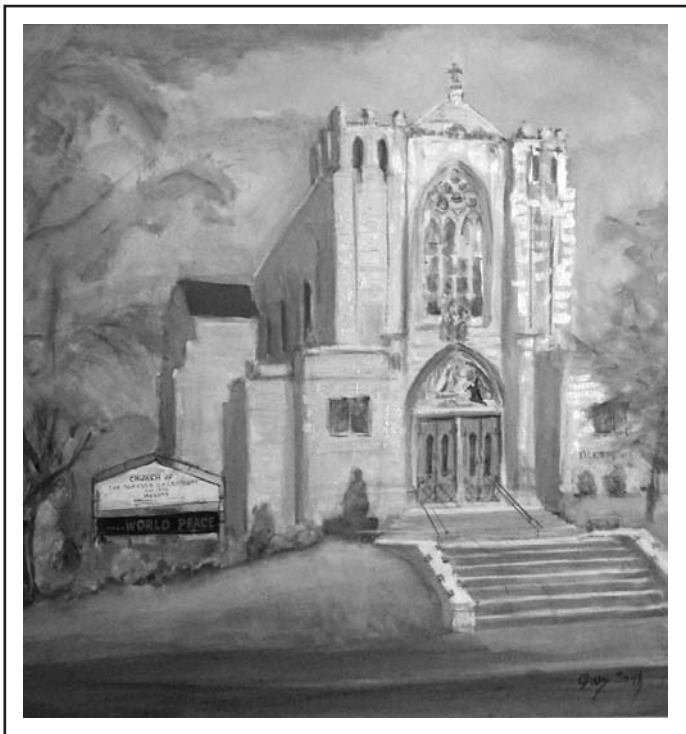

For registration parents must come to the parish office, Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. There is NO on-line registration. A copy of the Baptismal Certificate for all students who are participating in the First Communion or Confirmation programs ***is required in order to register.*** Fees: \$150 (cash or cheque) for students in the First Communion/First Reconciliation sacramental preparation and \$150 for students in the Confirmation sacramental preparation - payable to Blessed Sacrament Church.
