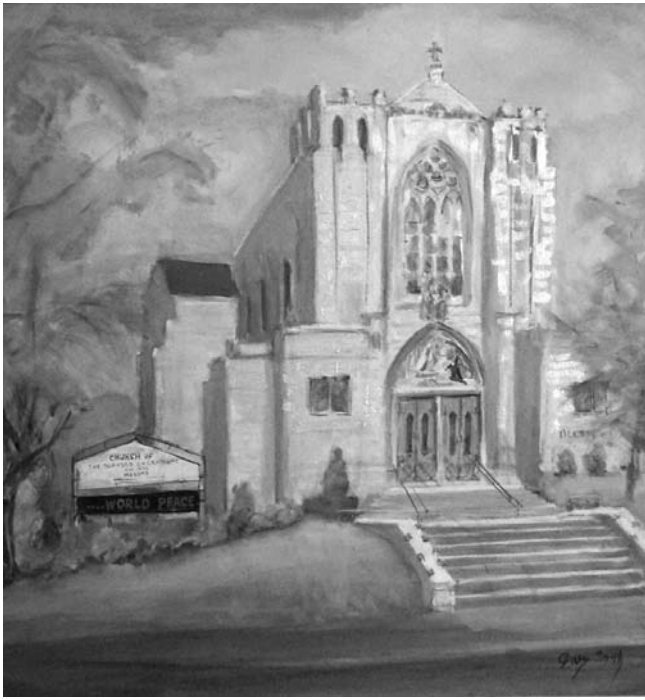

Sunday, October 4 - 2:00 - 3:00 pm - Life Chain is a peaceful and silent witness to the injustice of abortion and the harm it inflicts on women and the community at large. It is a simple but powerful reminder to our fellow citizens of the sanctity of human life and our duty to defend the weakest members of our society.

The very first Life Chain was held in 1987 in Yuba City, California and consisted of 2,500 people. The annual event grew by leaps and bounds in the following years, with Canada holding its first Life Chain in 1990, and almost 1,000,000 participating across North America in 1992. Last year, there were over 250 Life Chains in Canada and over 15,000 are estimated to have participated from coast to coast.

This year, we will be marking 30 years of Life Chain in Canada. Most Life Chains will be held on Sunday, October 4th. Our nearest Life Chain is Avenue Road and Wilson or Yonge and Eglinton. www.canpaignlifecoalition.com/lifechain

Before entering the seminary I studied astronomy and astrophysics (for 6 years); I was teaching, performing in the arts and working with homeless, drug addicts and youth. My vocation came through Neocatechumenal Way, which I have encountered during my university studies. Also, I was evangelizing as a lay missionary catechist in Poland and Belarus. 9 years ago I began my priestly formation in Redemptoris Mater Missionary Seminary of Toronto.

During my studies, I had the opportunity to do one year of work and study in Israel, and one year of mission in Blessed Sacrament Parish in Vancouver, BC (not here :-). At present, I have completed my third year of theology.

Some things I like to do are: hiking, playing musical instruments, researching and working with the youth. I feel very welcome in this parish and I am looking forward to meeting all of you. Please pray for me.
